QUICK FACTS:

- Many top tier colleges require applicants to submit two - three Subject Test scores in addition to SAT I scores. These scores are used for admission purposes and course placement.
- SAT Subject Tests are offered six times a year in the United States and at international sites.
- Students can take one, two, or three tests on a single test date.
- Each test takes one hour.
- All Subject Tests consist of multiple-choice questions, but some have unique features or formats.
- The types of questions change little from year to year.
- All Subject Tests are machine scored.
